E2 School Supplies

Personal Supplies

Fourth year students will need to bring the following supplies. (Fifth and Sixth year students should already have these items, but some may need to be replaced.)

zippered binder (such as Meade 5 star)
 2 one inch binders (white) for **Homework** and **Geometry**
 letter sized clip board
 1 zippered pencil pocket (3 hole punched for binder)
 3"x5" index card box
 1 set of "3"x5" index card tab dividers
 1 pair scissors (i.e. Fiskars pointed tip)
 shatter proof ruler (with both English and metric measurement)
 1 package 12 count colored pencils
 1 5 subject spiral notebook (all students)
 1 Locker Mate or free standing shelf

Community Supplies

Middle School Supplies

Recycle or re-use as much as possible! If you have a workable binder from last year, use it again. If you can find paper, pens, markers, and pencils from home, use them until they run out of ink or lead.

Organizing binder (like the Mead five-star binder)

Dividers with tabs—16—(Sometimes those with pockets are helpful for organization.)

Clear sheet protectors—25 or so—(Some people find side-opening protectors helpful.)

Book cover for math

Calculator (Casio's fx-250HC or Texas Instruments' TI-30Xa or equivalent)

Three-ring binders: 1 @ 1 inch for math (blue)

1 @ 1 inch for Spanish (white)

Loose leaf paper (You must always have paper in your binder. Keep it readily available.)

Loose leaf graph paper, 4 or 5 sq. per inch (You must always have graph paper in your math binder.)

Pens—two different colors—and pencils (You must always have them in the classroom so keep extras on hand.)

Colored markers (fine) OR colored pencils (at least 4 colors)

For the Classroom

Paper towels (preferably recycled) - 1 roll

Dry erase markers—4, any colors

500 sheets of computer paper (preferably recycled)

Hand soap

Tissues

Optional Supplies

Dishwasher soap
